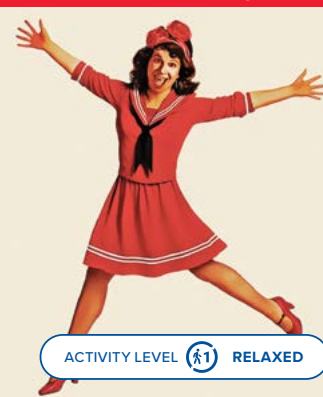

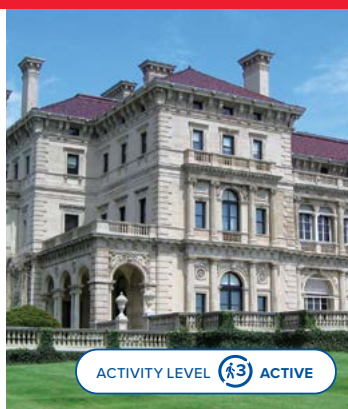

AAA GROUP TRAVEL ACTIVITY LEVELS

The AAA group travel activity levels are progressive in nature.

(1) = RELAXED - Leisurely pace • Shorter touring days • Some physical activity required, including independently boarding and disembarking a motorcoach.

(2) = COMFORTABLE - Easy pace • Some stairs and standing • Short duration walks typically on level terrains.

(5) = STRENUOUS - Vigorous pace • Frequent strenuous activities • Extensive walking • Longer tour days • Walking on varied terrain.

(3) = ACTIVE - Moderate pace • Good mobility needed • Stairs and prolonged standing for more than 2 hours at a time • Some longer days involving early mornings and/or late evenings • Some walking on varied terrain. *This Activity Level is not recommended for travelers with mobility issues such as someone who uses a cane, walker, or wheelchair.*

(4) = CHALLENGING - Fast pace • Frequent physically challenging activities • Walking on varied terrain and/or up to two miles at a time • Longer tour days. *This Activity Level is not recommended for travelers with serious medical conditions.*
